

## Correction to “Evolution of first- and second-year snow properties on sea ice in the Weddell Sea during spring-summer transition”

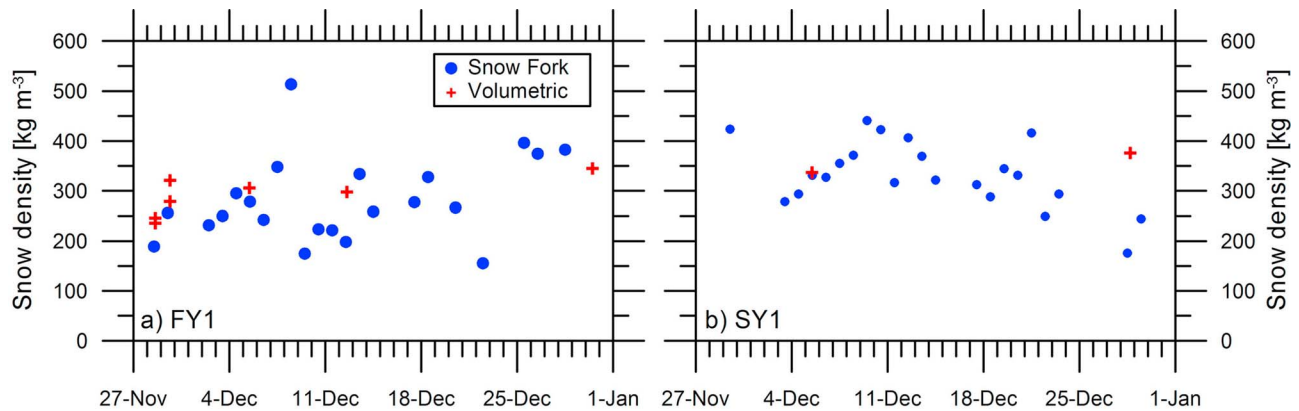

[2] In the online version, Figure 9 is identical to Figure 10, where Figure 10 is correct and Figure 9 is wrong. However, the caption of Figure 9 is correct. The corrected version of Figure 9 is as follows.
